

Transfer of Shares on Death - Expression of Wish

You can nominate a person (aged 18 or over) or an organisation to whom you wish your shares to be transferred on your death. The Society will respect your wishes insofar as the law and our Rules permit.

You could choose to nominate Norton Lindsey Community Pub Limited which would in effect make it a beneficiary under your will.

If you choose not to nominate anyone your executors will deal with your shares as part of the administration of your estate and can apply to have them transferred on the same terms as other members.
